New Kids in School!

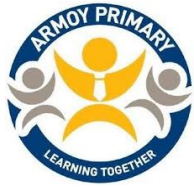
We had a lovely visit on Friday morning from Dandelion & Daffodil, two little pygmy goats! They were kindly brought in by Maggie Christie who rescued them both.

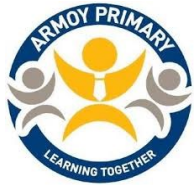

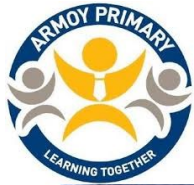
